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
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
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<u>Turning Off the Engine at Traffic Initiative by TN Rao College</u>

Students and faculty took a pledge to conserve water and promote sustainable practices in their daily lives.

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

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
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Promoting Inclusivity:

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
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Date : 26th July, 2022 Collaboration: 15 CORPS OP SIG REGT
