2. Scope of Services

- Appropriate measures will be taken to protect personal data and comply with data protection laws and regulations.

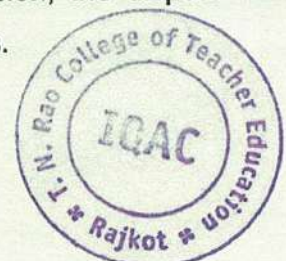
7. Dispute Resolution
