To make education more experimental, NCTE has made the teacher training course for Two years, and during this two years, Six months has been allotted for Internship Programme. Thus, There is no option to provide intensive scholastic experiences for trainees except Internship Programme.

- Prepare a handwritten magazine by the students on any one educational subject.
